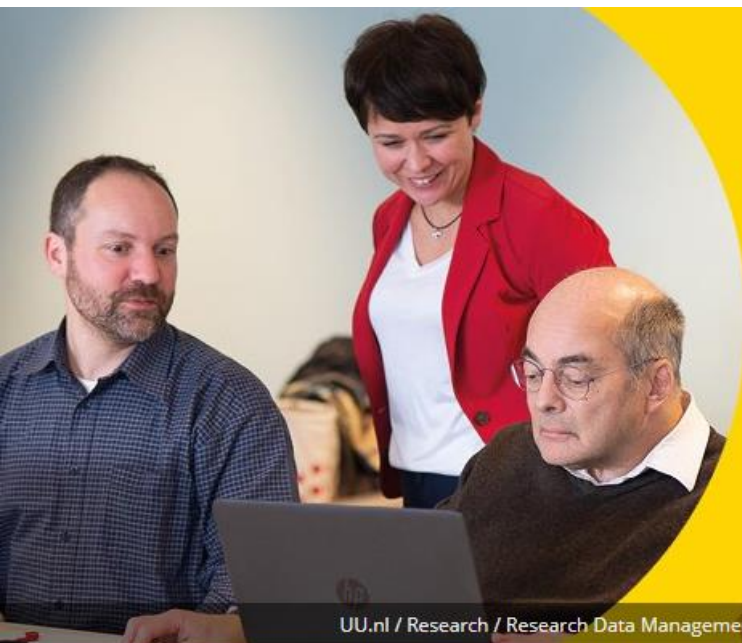

## Community and cooperation and contacts

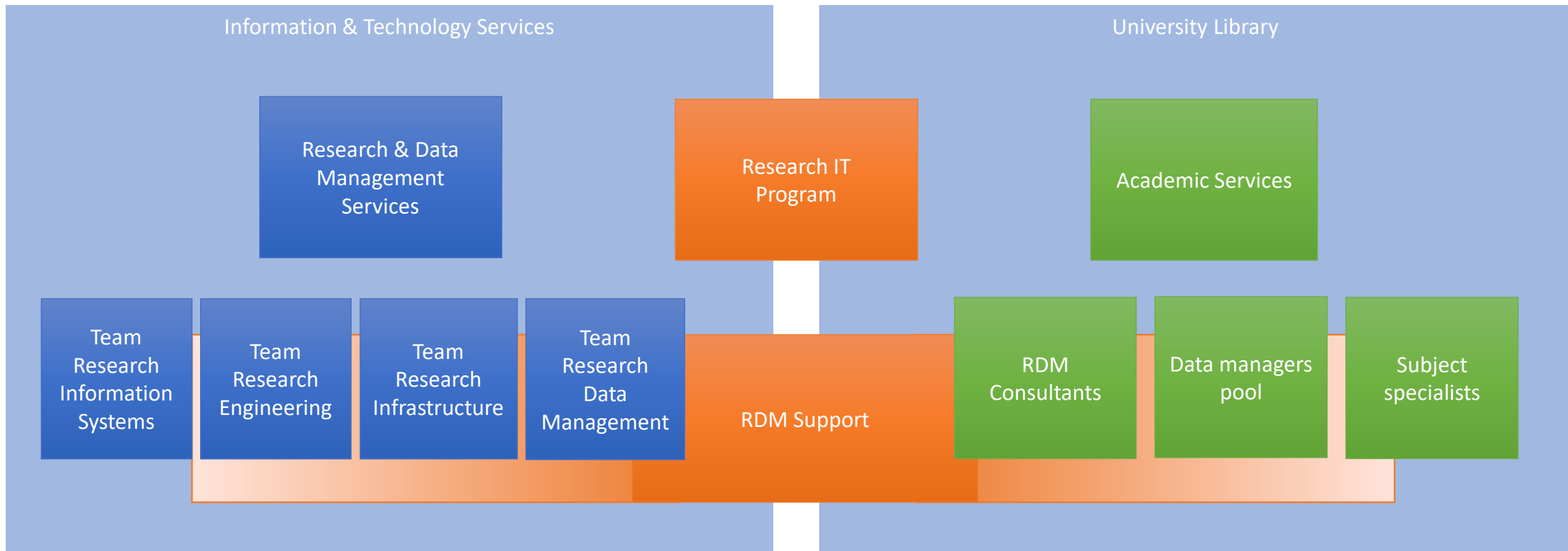

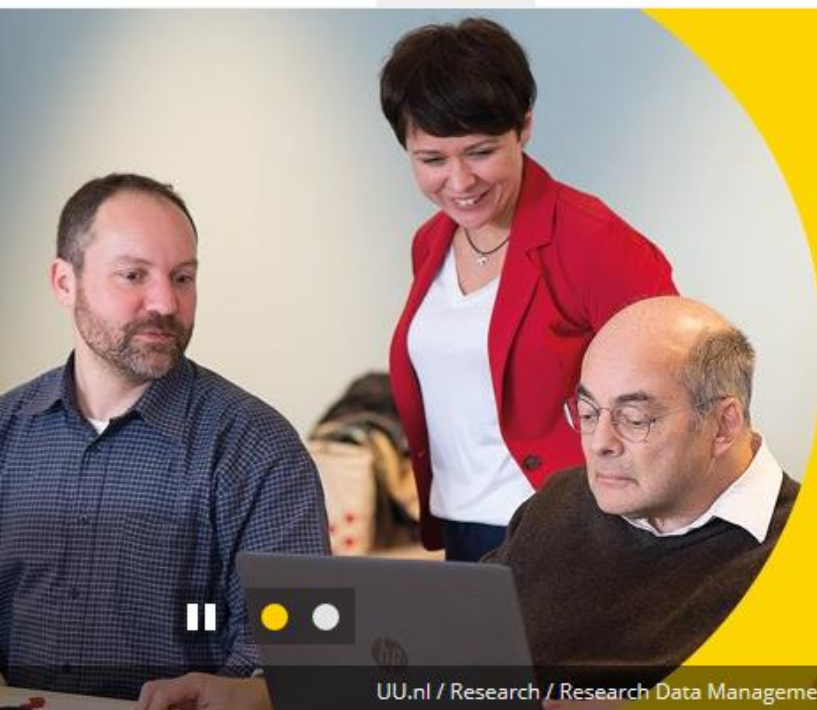

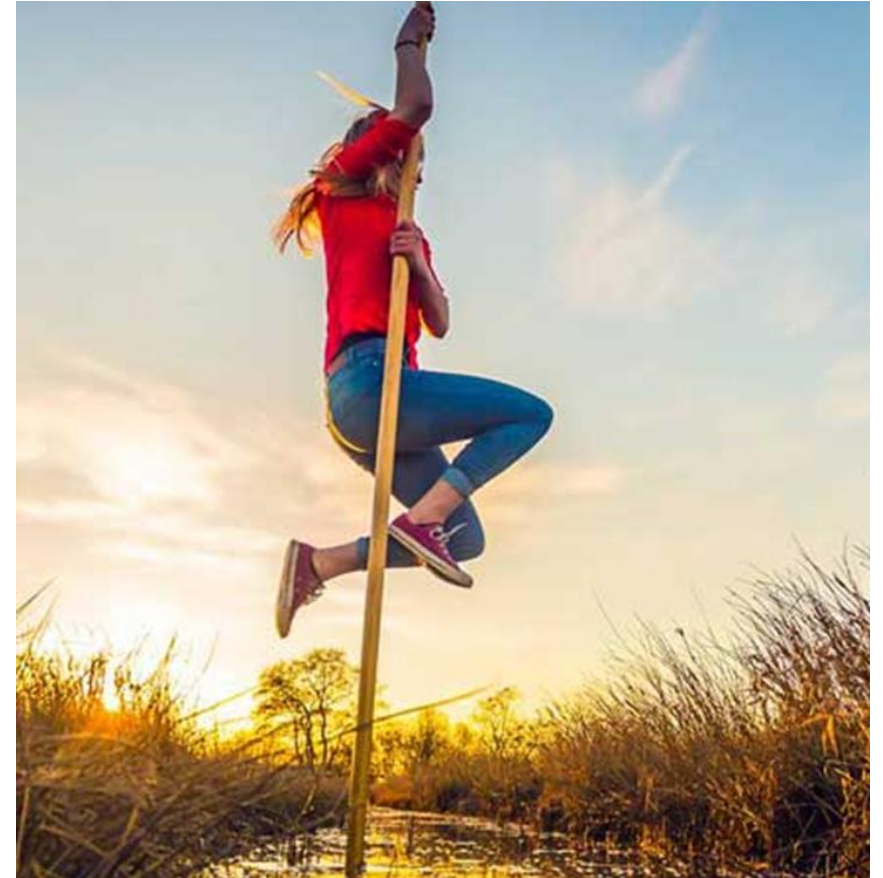
