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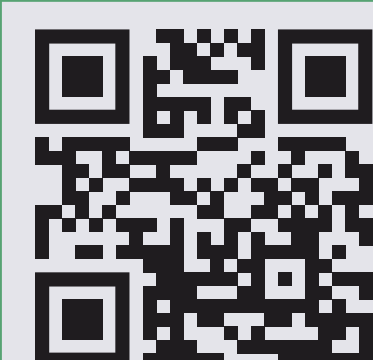
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How RDA-NL is Shaping the Future of Research Data

Overview of RDA-NL:

RDA-NL is relatively new. In its first two years, RDA-NL has engaged in a variety of community building initiatives, has highlighted member outputs related to RDA groups, and hopes to gain insight from other communities on what works for them.
